The Small Print

The Yorkshire Rowing Council's (YRC) aim is to promote rowing in the Yorkshire Region. To fulfil this aim the YRC will provide funding towards the cost of courses which will benefit the applicant as well as ARA registered rowers in the wider Yorkshire Region.

Club and Coach Grants

1. The Yorkshire Regional Council (YRC) secured funding towards the cost of the UKCC level 2 & 3 courses of £80 and £200 respectively per candidate.
2. The Club and Coach grants are awarded and managed by the YRC Coaching Commission.
3. The grant will generally be paid at the end of the calendar year, but the timing is not guaranteed.
4. The recipient must be registered ARA member and a member of a rowing club in the Yorkshire Sport England Region.

Yorkshire Rowing Council Grants

1. All grant are awarded at the discretion of the YRC.
2. The recipient must be a member of an ARA affiliated club in the Yorkshire Region, but need not be an ARA member.
3. The recipient must demonstrate the benefit of the grant to members of YRC rowing clubs e.g. coaching, launch driving etc.
4. **All payments for a course must be made in full before being accepted onto the course.**
5. All requests for funding must be made in writing before the start of the course and sent to the Secretary of the Yorkshire Rowing Council.
6. The grant will be paid on completion of the course, after all course work has been submitted, but irrespective of the candidate passing the course. The YRC may make discretionary payments before full completion.
7. All grants must be claimed within 12 months of the grant being awarded.
8. The grant will only cover course fees, and excludes travel costs and other ancillary expenses. Residential costs are included if they are part of the course fee.
9. The level of the grant is determined after all other sources of funding are taken into account e.g. Continuous Professional Development funds, Club and Coach Awards, Awards for All, ARA grants etc which must be stated.
10. The maximum grant awarded is a third of the course fees or £250 which ever is smaller **providing funds are available.**
11. The grant must be matched by the recipients club, and the Club Treasurer must sign the application form to guarantee this.

All requests for funding must be made at the same time a course is applied for, and no less than 28 days before the start of the course.
