The Small Print

The Yorkshire Rowing Council's (YRC) aim is to promote rowing in the Yorkshire Region. To fulfil this aim the YRC will provide funding towards the cost of courses which will benefit the applicant as well as BR registered rowers in the wider Yorkshire Region.

YRC may, subject to funds being available, offer financial assistance on approved training courses of up to $\frac{1}{3}$ of the cost to the candidates, with a maximum award of £250

The following conditions will apply:

1. All grants are awarded at the discretion of the YRC.
2. The candidate will be a registered member of British Rowing and a member of a Yorkshire Regional Club.
3. **All payments for a course must be made in full before being accepted onto the course.**
4. The candidate Club will formally endorse the candidate attending the course and agree to match fund any award from the YRC.
5. Candidates are expected and will be given assistance to apply for funding from outside sources.
6. By applying for financial assistance from YRC the candidate agrees to inform the YRC of the value of any financial contribution received from outside sources towards the cost of the course.
7. The grant will be paid on completion of the course, after all course work has been submitted, but irrespective of the candidate passing the course. The YRC may make discretionary payments before full completion.
8. Grants will be paid to the recipients club.
9. All grants must be claimed within 12 months of the grant being awarded.
10. The grant will only cover course fees, and excludes travel costs and other ancillary expenses. Residential costs are included if they are part of the course fee.

The level of award that may be given, will be calculated as per the example below:

All requests for funding must be made at the same time a course is applied for, and no less than 28 days before the start of the course.
