## ROWING CLUB TRAILER DRIVER VEHICLE AUDIT

It is important that drivers of towing vehicles are aware of their vehicle's limitations with regard to the number and type of boats they can safely and legally tow. It is also important that the correct towing hitch weight is known so that the load can be adjusted to suit.

To enable the Club to help you in these matters of safety please fill in the details below (some of which can be found in your vehicle's handbook)
